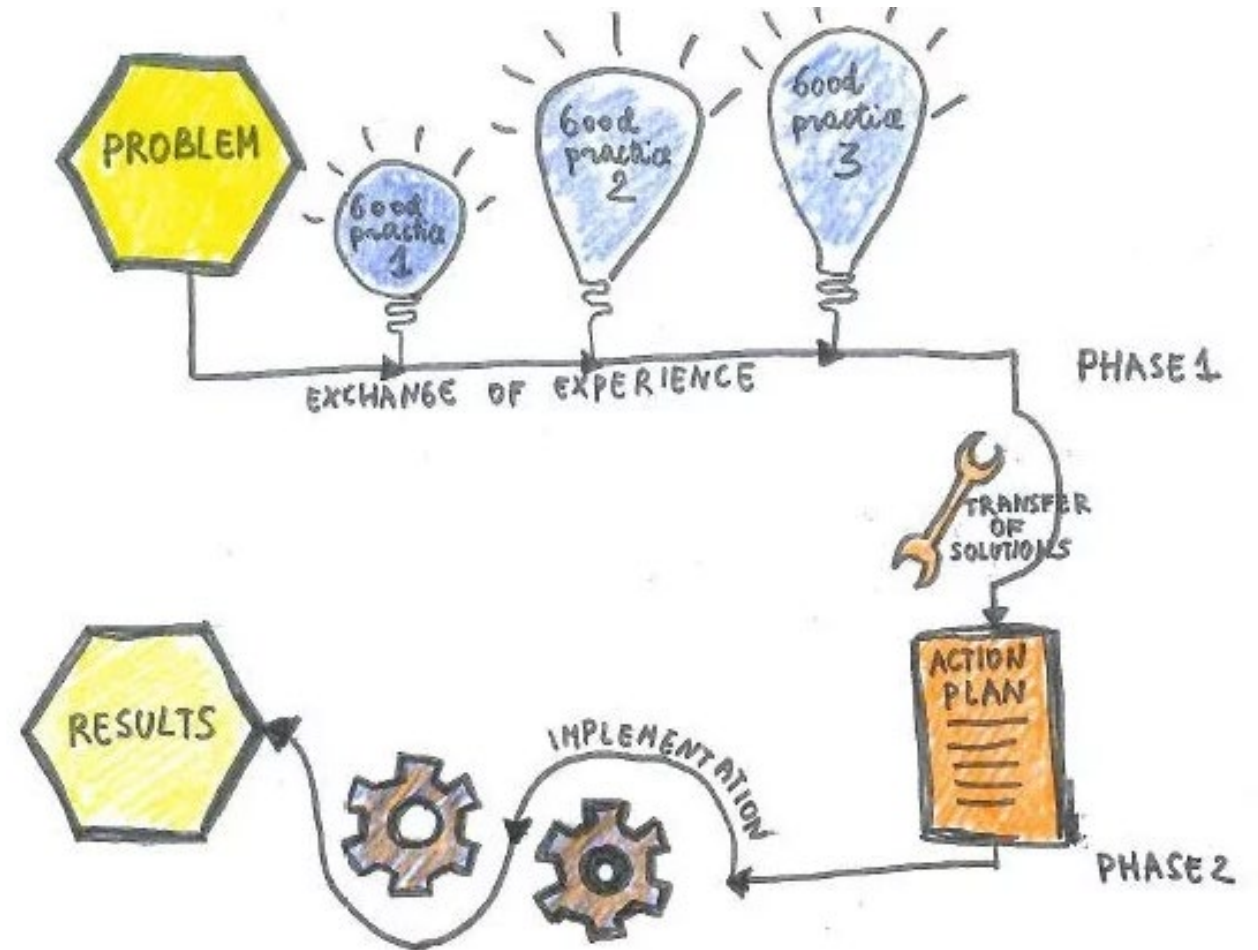

- 100% financing available to end June 2021

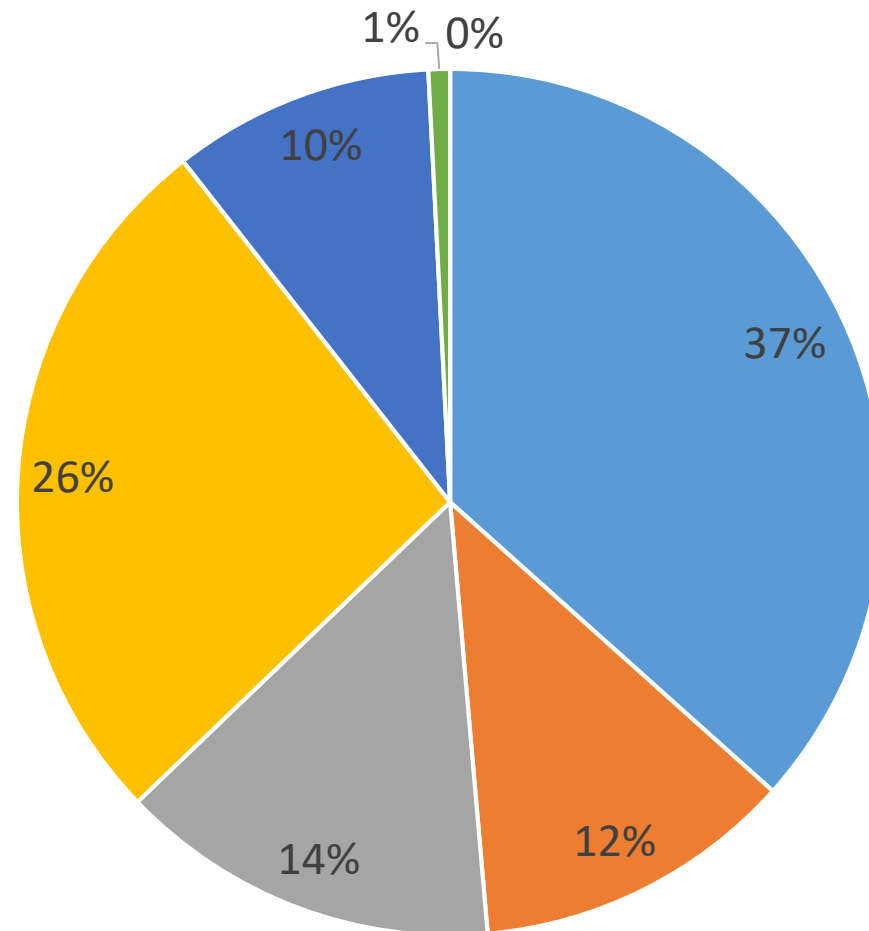


Decision in Ireland to avail of CRII & CRII+

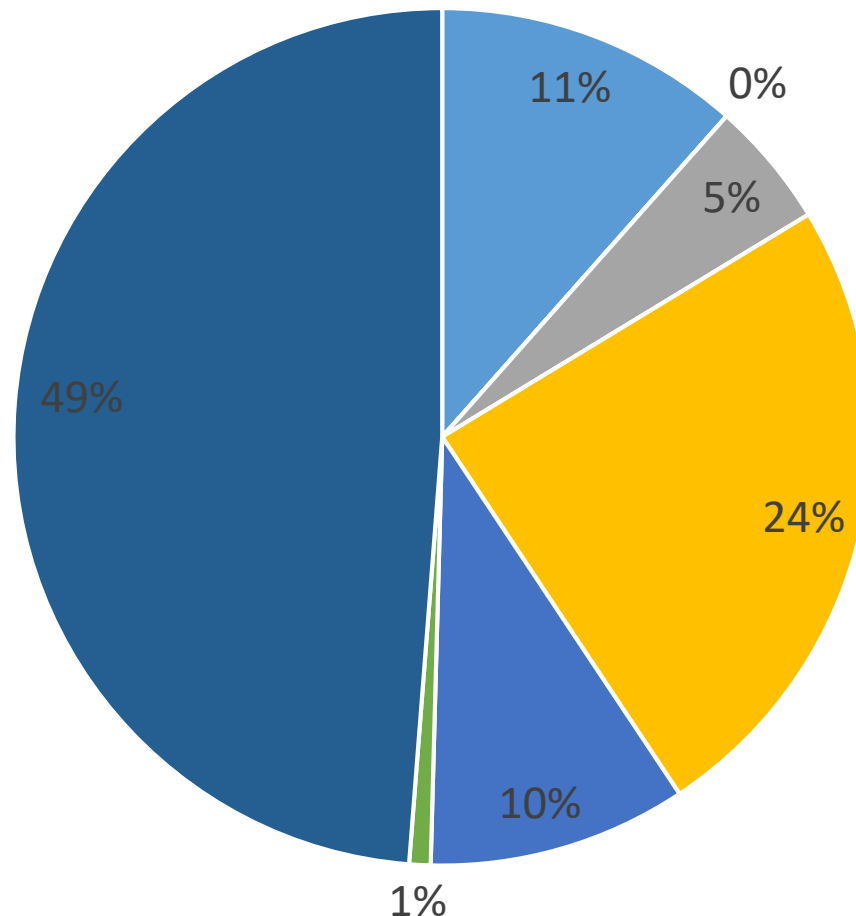
