SUBMISSION

Since the advent of the County and City Council amalgamation in 2014, Waterford Metropolitan Council consists of three electoral areas. One of these is the EA of “Tramore/Waterford City West”.

Tramore is thus - signally and legislatively - part of Waterford Metropolitan.

In the RSES, Tramore is NOT considered to be part of Waterford Metropolitan.

This is at variance with the local authority reform document “Putting People First”, and the legislation that underpins it.
