Proposed Material Amendments to the Draft Regional Spatial and Economic Strategy for the Southern Region

Notice is hereby given pursuant to section 24 (8) of the Planning and Development Acts 2000-2018 that the Southern Regional Assembly propose material amendments to the Draft Regional Spatial and Economic Strategy for the Southern Region and has determined that a Strategic Environmental Assessment and an Appropriate Assessment are required in respect of one or more of the Proposed Material Amendments. Accordingly, an Environmental Report has been prepared to supplement the SEA Environmental Report; Regional Flood Risk Appraisal Report; and Natura Impact Report previously prepared on the Draft Regional Spatial and Economic Strategy.
